## Helpful Questions and Answers

**Q:** Can you help me with transportation to and from treatment services?

**A:** Yes! Treatment providers can help you, be sure to ask for more information.

---

**Q:** Can you help me with daycare while I'm in treatment?

**A:** Some providers have on-site daycare, others will assist you with local daycare options.

---

**Q:** Is my treatment private from my friends and family?

**A:** This is your decision. Treatment providers will not share information about your treatment without your consent.

---

**Q:** Will my Medicaid cover this?

**A:** Medicaid will cover outpatient treatment at a number of treatment agencies. The *Special Connections* program covers outpatient and residential treatment through Medicaid at Mental Health Partners in Boulder, Arapahoe House, ARTS/The Haven, Centennial Mental Health Center and Crossroads Turning Points.
